SERMON DISCUSSION & PRAYER PROMPTS

Discussion Questions:

- What is your favorite "Deliverance" story in the Bible? *(Examples: parting the Red Sea, Paul's escape from prison, David escaping King Saul, Jewish people escaping massacre in Esther)*
- Vulnerable Question Alert! What is something God has delivered you from, or is delivering you from? Be specific! *(For example: an addiction, toxic relationship, unhealthy habit, legalism)*
- If you were to be honest, which area of your spiritual life could you benefit from growing in more: Strengthening your prayer life or relying on the power of the Holy Spirit.

Prayer Prompts:

- God, when I was imprisoned by _____, thank you for delivering me!
