SERMON NOTES

“Christ Be Exemplified”

Key Text: Philippians 2:19-30

1. Our genuine concern for others is part of the fabric of who we are.

Insincere concern for others:

- *I only help when I can get recognition*
- *I only tell people what they want to hear*
- *I only serve when it's convenient for me*
- *Gossips under the guise of “prayer”*
- *Is impatient when someone makes a mistake*
- *Seeks personal recognition and credit*

Genuine concern for others:

- *I help even if no one notices*
- *I speak the truth in love (Eph 4:15)*
- *I serve when the Holy Spirit moves me to*
- *Handles a matter respectfully (Matt 18:15)*
- *Shows grace and extends forgiveness*
- *Seeks for God to be glorified*

2. We let our Gospel light shine despite setbacks, situations, and suffering.

3. We honor living examples in our lives.

SERMON DISCUSSION

Key Text: Philippians 2:19-30

1. In what ways might you struggle with showing insincere love toward others? Spend time praying for each other in this area.

2. What is a current struggle or hardship you are facing? How can you still let your Gospel light shine despite this?

3. Name one or two "Epaphrodituses" you have personally known. What makes this person worthy of honor? How can you acknowledge him or her?

4. *For those who didn't grow up in a Christian household * Remember Epaphroditus' background and the meaning of his name. How did your road lead to Jesus despite your background or upbringing.
