SERMON NOTES

"The Good News Has Come!" Mark 1:1-13

Facts about the gospel of Mark:

- 1. Mark is the shortest Gospel—16 chapters.
- 2. Written by John Mark who was not one of the 12 Disciples, but very familiar with the life and ministry of Jesus.
- 3. Written in Rome where many idols were worshipped.
- 4. Specific Audience were the Christians in Rome who undergoing persecution and suffering.
- 5. Emphasized Jesus as the Suffering Servant
- 6. Records more miracles than any other Gospel
- 7. Omits the birth and early life of Jesus. Starts with Jesus already an adult.

The coming of Jesus is the coming of good news (vs 1-3)

We can still continue John's mission of preparing the hearts and minds of those we meet to meet the risen Savior.

Am I living in such a way that makes Christianity attractive to non-believers? (vs 4)

Jesus knows when we are sincerely repentant (vs 5-6)

Do you recognize how grand Jesus is? (vs 8)

Is there anything in your life you are holding above the water? (vs 9-13)
